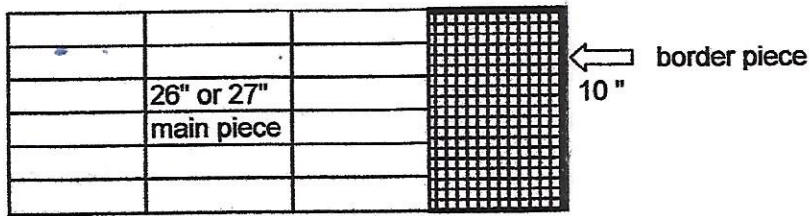


Easy Pillowcase (hot dog technique)

Main piece 26 or 27" x width of fabric
 Border 10" x width of fabric



1. Lay 10" border piece of fabric **right side up** on table, cut side at top.
2. Lay main piece **right side up** on top of border fabric, cut edge at top.
3. Pin across the two layers of fabric.
4. Roll the main fabric in a roll, like a hot dog.
5. Fold the border fabric up and over the rolled fabric. Re-pin all three pieces together along long edge.
6. Sew across the fabric, Creates one long roll. Pull the main piece of fabric out. and iron seams flat.
7. Cut salvedge edges of fabric to straighten sides.
8. Sew french seam along side. (French seam: Sew **wrong sides** together 1/4 seam. Turn fabric so right sides are together and sew 5/8" seam.) Sew top seam of fabric with 1/4" seam, and zig zag top edge.
9. Turn pillowcase so right side is out and iron.
