Easy Pillowcase (hot dog technique)

Main piece Border 26 or 27" x width of fabric 10" x width of fabric

- 1. Lay 10" border piece of fabric right side up on table, cut side at top.
- 2. Lay main piece right side up on top of border fabric, cut edge at top.
- 3. Pin across the two layers of fabric.
- 4. Roll the main fabric in a roll, like a hot dog.
- Fold the border fabric up and over the rolled fabric. Re-pin all three pieces together along long edge.
- Sew across the fabric, Creates one long roll. Pull the main piece of fabric out. and iron seams flat.
- 7. Cut salvedge edges of fabric to straighten sides.
- Sew french seam along side. (French seam: Sew <u>wrong sides</u> together 1/4 seam.
 Turn fabric so right sides are together and sew 5/8" seam.) Sew top seam of fabric with 1/4" seam, and zig zag top edge.
- 9. Turn pillowcase so right side is out and iron.
